In order to provide secondary school students with a continuum of education without unnecessary duplication of instruction and delay in attaining educational/career objectives, **Butler County Community College** and **Jefferson County-DuBois Area Vocational Technical School** have entered into this articulation agreement for the following program(s) and/or courses:

GENERAL

Before advanced credit can be awarded, the following conditions must be fulfilled:

- 1. Applicants for advanced credit must meet the College's requirements for admission, plus any specific program requirements, if applicable.
- 2. Application for advanced credit by articulation must be made within two years after coursework at the secondary institution has been completed.
- 3. Applicants will receive advanced credit on their transcripts after successful completion of 12 college credits at Butler County Community College and within two and one-half years after graduation from the secondary institution.
- 4. The Jefferson County-Dubois Area Vocational Technical School will notify the College of any modification in the testing program.
- 5. This agreement will be in effect until either of the two parties wish to revisit the terms of the agreement.

SPECIFICS

- 1. No grade appears on the transcript; however credits are granted.
- 2. Each student must contact the Registrar's office at Butler County Community College to apply for advanced credit.
- 3. Each student will provide the Registrar's office with a copy of the Cosmetology Certification awarded by the PA State Board of Cosmetology.
